Founded in 2007, Project ReDirect (PRD) is a reputable 501(c)3 nonprofit organization with a substantial history of providing essential Human Services to individuals and families facing various Social Services, Clinical, Homelessness, and Medical Challenges.

PRD operates a range of residential and on-site service programs across multiple locations, including New York City, the District of Columbia, and Las Vegas, Nevada.



WHAT WE DO

As a certified provider of Home and Community Based Services, PRD specializes in delivering Residential Housing and Day Program Services tailored to the needs of specific populations, including immigrants, individuals with intellectual and physical disabilities, and those requiring specialized medical care.

In July 2023, PRD secured a contract with the NYC Department of Homeless Services to operate Asylum Seeker Homeless Shelters. Presently, we provide daily housing and support to families with children across five NYC Asylum Seeker Shelters.

Project ReDirect is committed to those individuals who have experienced life challenges through our programs such as a Homeless Shelters, Day Treatment Programs, Arts Programs, and Vocational Rehabilitation Programs.

Established Six emergency Asylum Seeker Homeless Shelters in New York, accommodating over 3000 individuals daily.

On average, we have successfully secured permanent housing for 35 families per month. Over 75% of on site staff are bilingual.
